The Conservatives have, in order to pay for their new employment policy, proposed retesting current recipients of Incapacity Benefit and moving those they deem 'fit to work' onto Jobseekers' allowance, which pays £24 a week less.

In order to fund their new employment policy in this way would mean that 500,000 people currently deemed to be unable to work due to health reasons, would need to be moved over to Jobseekers' Allowance and receive a lower benefit package.
